On Saturday, May 17th, the public is invited to attend a fundraiser, Dance & Arts to End Child Abuse. Child abuse is not just physical or sexual, but includes psychological abuse. Psychological abuse is not something you can see, like broken bones, red marks and bruises. The scars are internal. This form of abuse can lead to the destruction of a loving relationship between one healthy parent and their children by a parent using tactics such as custodial interference and badmouthing. This can happen in all sorts of families but it is most prevalent in difficult divorce and custody cases. It is commonly referred to as Parental Alienation.

In the absence of abuse, children deserve two loving parents. Children of alienation may suffer from self-hate, depression and trust issues well into adulthood due to psychological abuse. This form of abuse tears once loving families apart.

PASI (Psychological Abuse Support and Intervention) is a Non-profit, federally tax exempt organization dedicated to ending psychological abuse and parental alienation. PASI works toward raising the awareness of professionals, such as court personnel and evaluators, on the methods of recognizing true abuse from false allegations. In addition to training, the proceeds help victims, provide financial assistance, educate families, fund research/studies and keep the services of PAS Intervention free.
